



Setting Parental Controls: iPhone, iPod Touch, & iPad

You can enable and adjust Restrictions on your device to prevent access to specific features or content on the device.

1. Locate these settings by tapping **Settings > General > Restrictions**.
2. To Enable Restrictions, tap **Enable Restrictions** and enter a **passcode**. The passcode will be required to make changes to these settings or to disable restrictions.
3. You can choose to restrict access to the following applications and features on the device:

- Safari
- YouTube
- Camera (also disables FaceTime)
- FaceTime
- iTunes
- Ping
- Installing apps
- Deleting apps
- Multiplayer games in Game Center
- Adding friends in Game Center

4. You can choose to prevent changes to the following settings/accounts:

- Location Services
- Accounts (disables changes to Mail, Contacts, Calendars, iCloud, and Twitter accounts)

5. In addition, you can choose to prevent access to specific content types:

Ratings (select the country in the ratings section to automatically apply the appropriate content ratings for that region)

Music and podcasts

Movies

TV shows
