

## Setting Parental Controls: Kindle Fire

- 1. Tap the Quick Settings>More>Parental Controls
- 2. Switch Enable Parental Controls to the on position
- 3. Follow the onscreen instructions to set a Parental Controls password.
- 4. Next use option to enable Password Protected Wi-Fi on your Kindle Fire.
  - Enabling Password Protected Wi-Fi turns off Wi-Fi on your device and will require your password to reactivate Wi-Fi. Parents may use this feature to prevent children from purchasing content or from browsing online.
- 5. You will see a Key icon to the right of the Quick Settings icon whenever Password Protected Wi-Fi is enabled and Wi-Fi is off.
- 6. Kindle Fire also supports parental controls for in-app purchases through the Amazon Appstore.

If you forget your password, you can reset your device to regain access. Resetting your Kindle Fire to the factory default settings will delete all content on your device and you'll need to register it again before downloading items from your Amazon account. To reset your Kindle Fire: tap the Quick Settings icon, then tap More, then Device, then Reset to Factory Defaults.
